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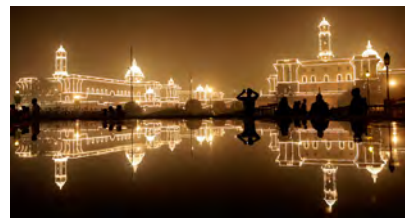
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Preface

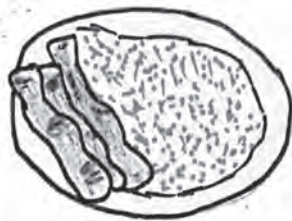
FAVORITE MONUMENTS OF DELHI

Favourite Market of Delhi

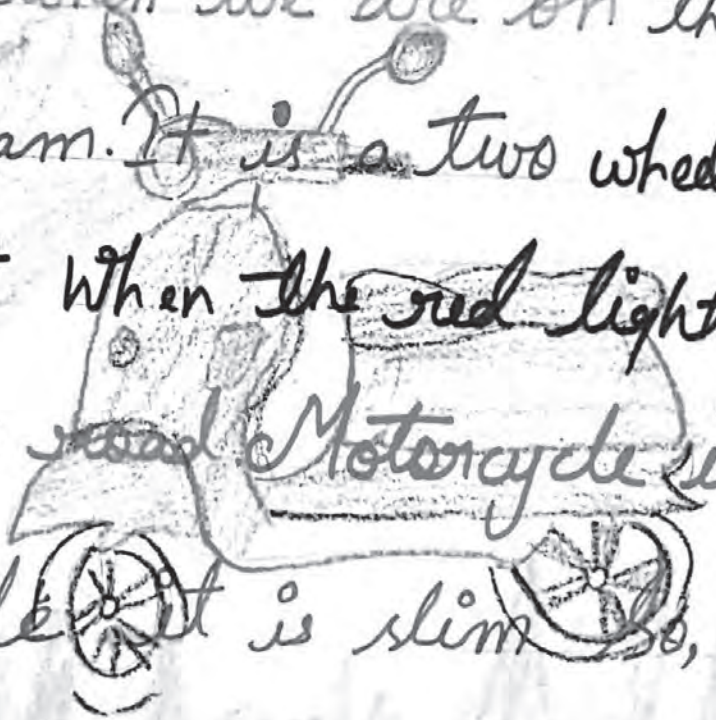

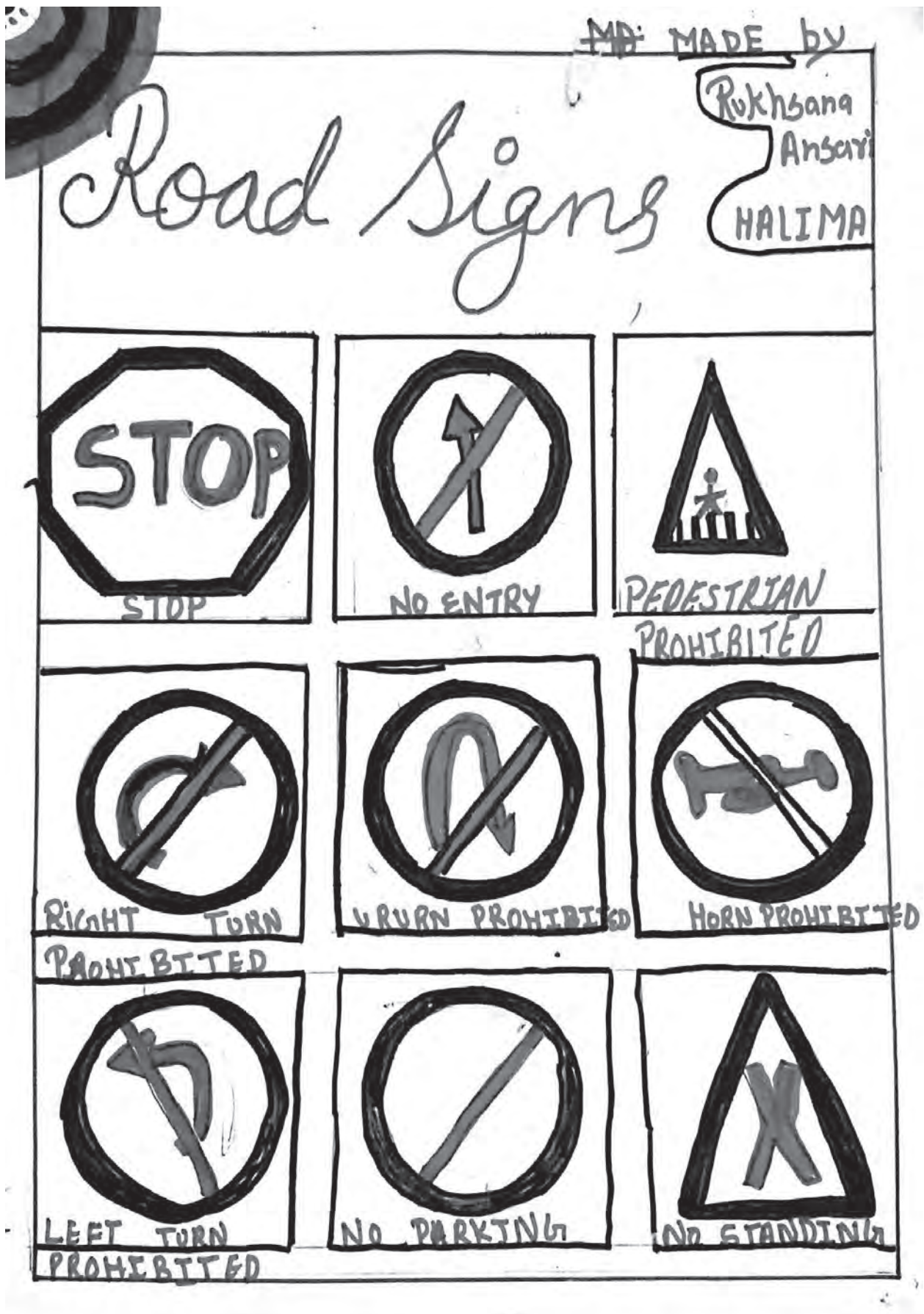

2. When we are in tunnel & the electricity is gone we can get stuck in it for at least 3 to 6 hours.
3. Some time Metro become too crowded that doors cannot be closed properly and then accidents happens.

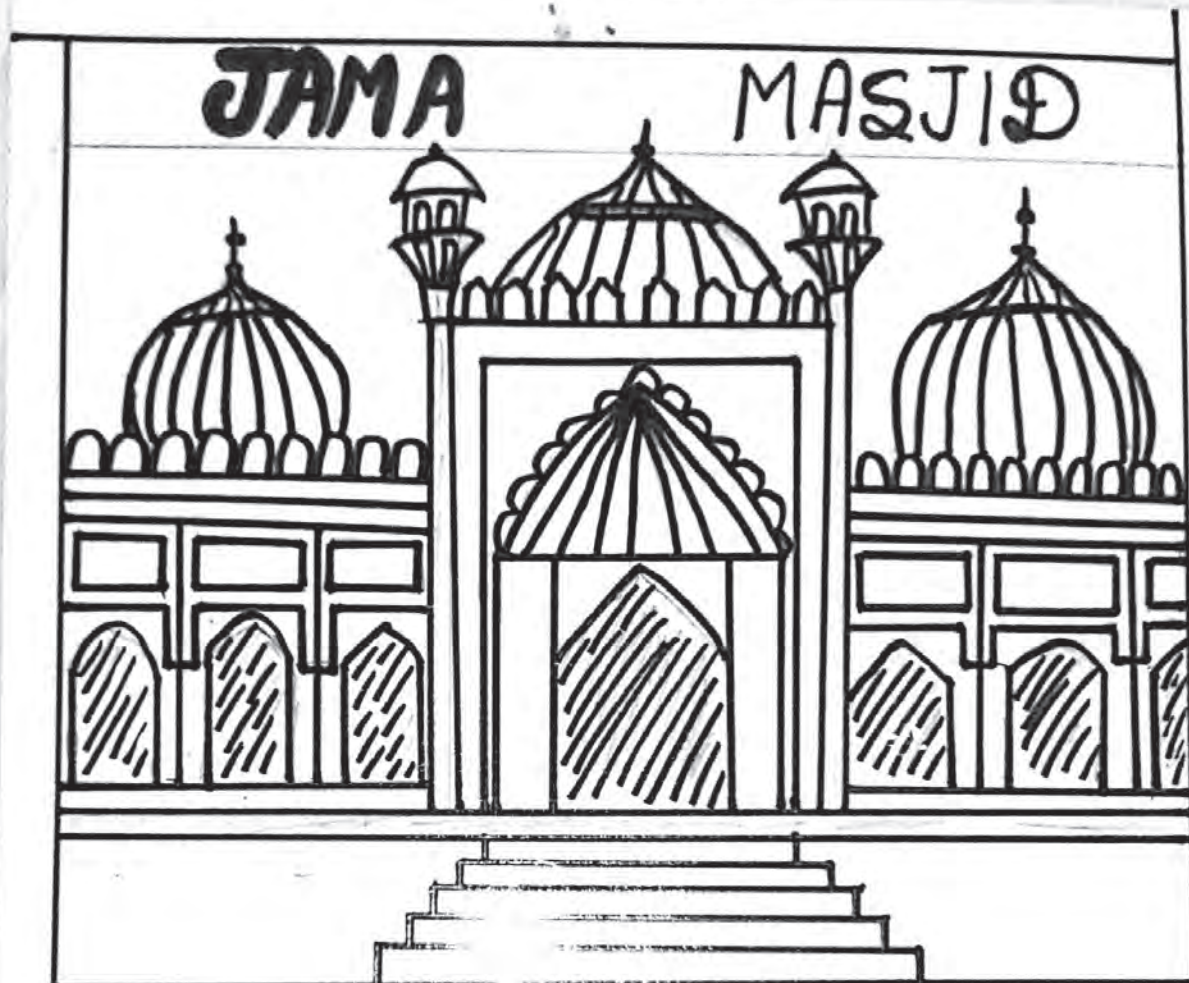


AKSHAR DHAM MANDIR

A visit to AMERICAN Center

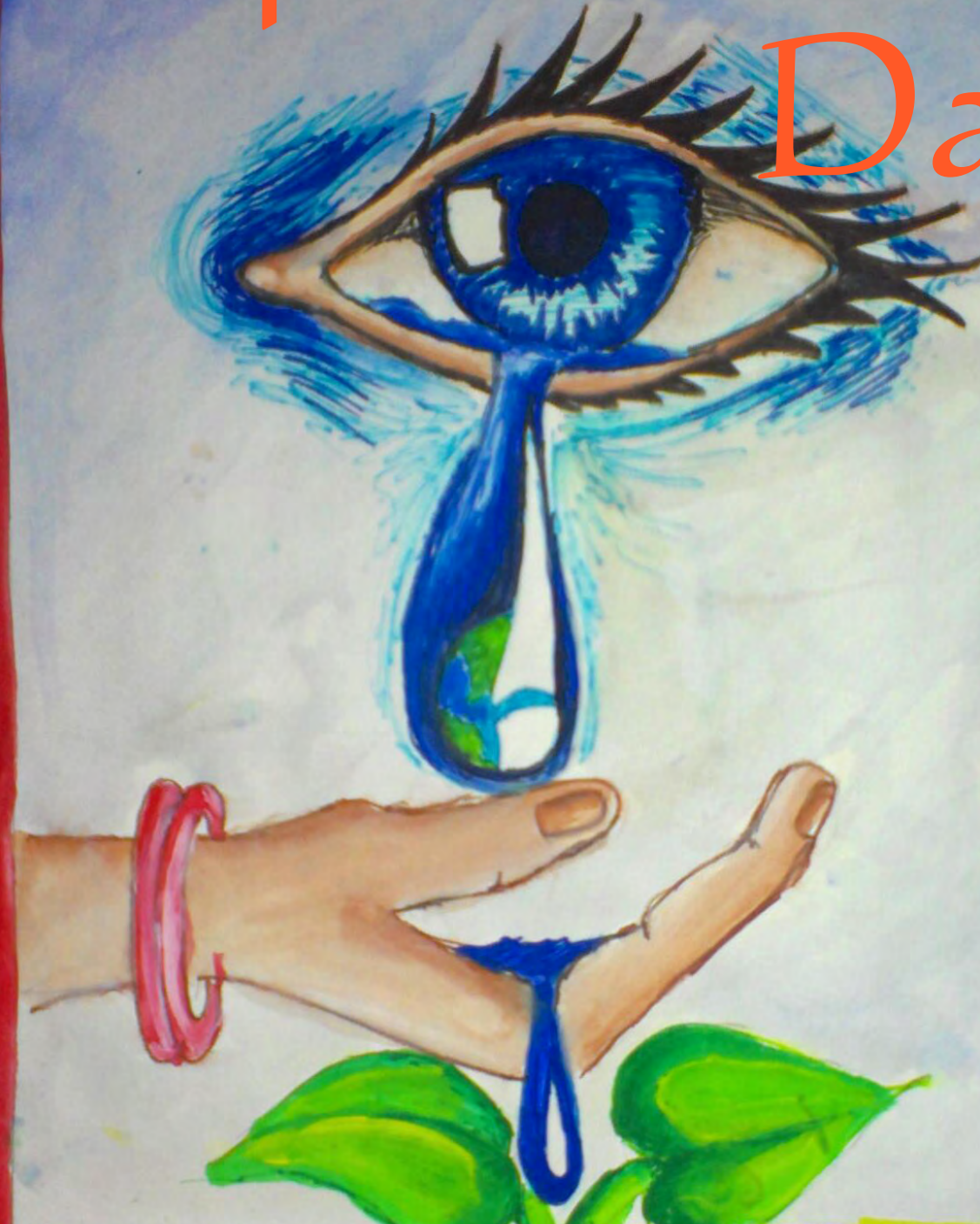

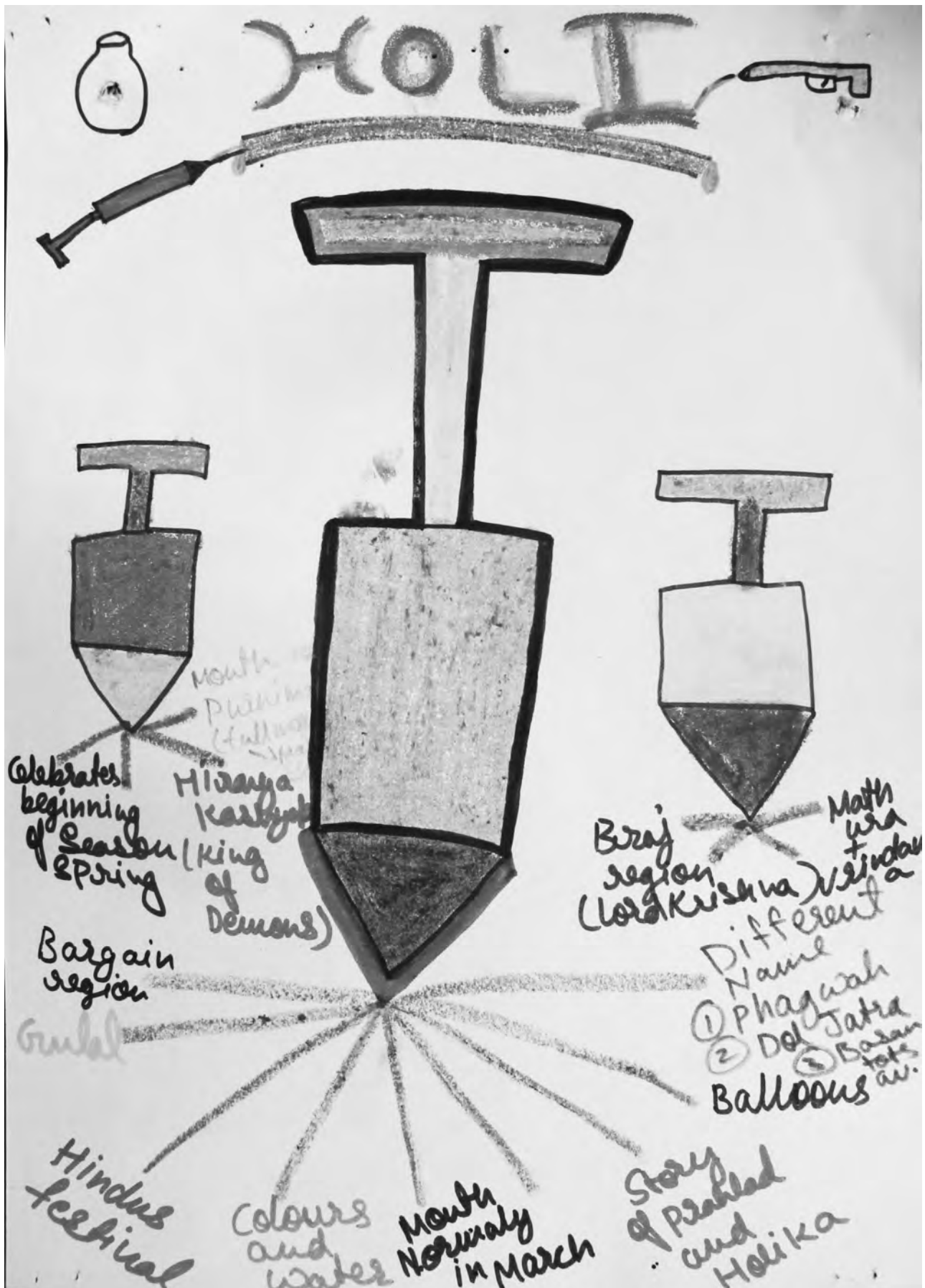


About Holi

The Access Micro-scholarship Programme is part of Aga Khan Development Network's Humayun's Tomb-Sunder Nursery-Hazrat Nizamuddin Basti Urban Renewal Initiative.

It was initiated with the support of the US Embassy to open up avenues for adolescents in the Hazrat Nizamuddin Basti in the age group of 14-16 years by developing their skills to use English language in every day life.

There are over 200 young girls and boys who participated in this program by 2012. The programme innovates teaching-learning techniques and attempts to channelize the creative potential of the students into the learning process.

This souvenir is a labor of love and inspiration – the inspiration comes from the search that hundreds of children are embarking upon the journey to gain fluency in the English language. Having realized that it is the need of the hour, the Aga Khan Development Network and the American Embassy are successfully running the 'English Access Micro Scholarship' program in the Hazrat Nizamuddin Basti.
